Can a local government prohibit the provision of personal wireless service?

60 We note that sections 253 and 332(c)(7) generally prohibit local governments from making regulatory decision that "prohibit or have the effect of prohibiting" the provision of personal wireless service or other forms of telecommunications service by any provider. See 47 U.S.C. &#167;&#167; 253(a) and 332(c)(7)(B)(i)(I).

Where should cell base stations be located?

An analysis of 100 studies published in Environmental Reviews found approximately 80% showed biological effects near towers. "As a general guideline, cell base stations should not be located less than 1500 ft from the population, and at a height of about 150 ft" (Levitt 2010).

This Section is enacted to establish a consistent set of standards regulating the placement and design of all types of communication facilities in unincorporated areas of Imperial County.
