How do I get to Nukualofa?

Nuku'alofo is the central hub for transport in Tonga. Buses arrive and depart from the central bus station along Vuna Road close to the centre of town. Bus services are privately operated, and their drivers are free to set their own schedules. Fares are fixed by the government, with reduced rates for school children.

Nuku'alofo (/ˈnuːkuˈloʔf/ /NOO-koo-ʔ-LOH-fʔ, Tongan: [nukuʔa'lofa]) is the capital and largest city of Tonga. It is located on the north coast of the island of Tongatapu, in the country's southernmost island group. On 10 June 1777, British captain James Cook wrote of his arrival at their anchorage place.

Why is Nukualofa the capital of Tonga?

The Declaration of the Constitution of Tonga in 1875 formalised Nuku'alofo as the Capital of Tonga. King George Taufu'ahau Tupou I issued the Constitution of Tonga on 4 November 1875, in Nuku'alofo. The Constitution also stated (Article 38) that the Parliament will meet in Nuku'alofo except in time of war.
